

Figure 2. Fall 2020 Cuyamaca Student Headcount by Gender





Figure 3. Fall 2020 Cuyamaca Student Headcount by Low-Income Status

Figure 4. Fall 2020 Cuyamaca Student Headcount by Units Attempted






Figure 5. Full-Time and Part-Time Faculty Race/Ethnicity Compared to Student Race/Ethnicity: 2019-2020
